Course Title: NURS 311.3 Core Competencies for the Management of Complex Patient Care

Pre-Requisites: NURS 221.3 – Patient and Family Centered Care in Clinical Practice

Course Description:

This course will provide opportunities for students to learn how to manage stable and high acuity patients across the lifespan. Advanced and more complex clinical skills will be taught using a combination of lecture, laboratory, and simulation.

Intent:

Learners will:

1. Demonstrate an ability to perform assessment in complex clinical situations.
2. Articulate evidence based rationale for intervention in complex situations.
3. Demonstrate skills required to provide complex interventions for client care.
