Call Launch: Canadian Research Chair (CRC) Theme Areas

The University of Saskatchewan's Canada Research Chairs Advisory Committee has invited colleges and schools to submit proposals for CRC theme areas. The University is positioned to award up to six Tier 2 and two Tier 1 CRCs. Theme area proposals may fit within any of the three federal research granting agencies (CIHR, SSHRC, NSERC). Colleges and schools are encouraged to initiate a consultative process within their units and with other colleges and schools to identify theme area recommendations. College of Nursing timelines are as follows:

OCTOBER 15: Deadline submission of theme applications to the College of Nursing Research Office.

OCTOBER 21 TO 28: Applications and internal ranking by Research and Scholarly Work Committee shared with College for final comments and feedback.

NOVEMBER 4: We will forward applications and rankings to the CRC Advisory Committee.
