Marion (Bailey) Grossman








Marion (Bailey) Grossman

Joan (Boxall) Swanson






Joan (Boxall) Swanson

Kathy (Morrison) Gifford







Kathy (Morrison) Gifford

- We continue to winter in south Texas near The Gulf of Mexico.










Linda (George) McDonald

- Married, two children, one grandchild.












Karen (Cowan) Lerner

Pat (Belsher) Hrabe






Pat (Belsher) Hrabe




Donna Maxwell
