

College of Nursing Graduate Student Travel Award

Value:

\$200 - \$1,000 depending on destination and purpose of travel.

Description:

The purpose of this award is to assist Master and PhD students in the College of Nursing with travel costs associated with presenting papers, posters or other creative work pertinent to their studies. Approved events include conferences, meetings or professional practice events that are sponsored by recognized national or international organizations.

Awardees are expected to gain experience and confidence in presenting their work in preparing for advanced practice roles in the nursing profession.

Application Deadline:

Applications are accepted year round with notification of decision within 30 days by the Graduate Studies Awards Committee.

Eligibility:

- Must be registered in a Nursing graduate program
- Must be presenting a paper or poster where the student is the principal author of the submitted peer reviewed abstract
- Students may receive only one travel award from the College of Nursing in each calendar year (SEP – AUG)
- Students are encouraged to apply for the U of S travel award

Application Procedure:

Complete and submit the following documents by email:

- Application Form providing detailed budget describing anticipated travel expenses
 Education Enhancement Bursary Application Form
- Copy of the abstract and acceptance letter from the organization
- Letter from your supervisor indicating whether matching funding is available

Reimbursement Procedure:

- Submission of an application does not guarantee funding
- Reimbursement up to the amount granted will be processed only upon submission of official receipts (airfare, ground travel, hotel accommodations, conference registration fees, food)
