FUNDAMENTALS OF FETAL HEALTH SURVEILLANCE

WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

The course is intended for practitioners (nurses, physicians, registered midwives) who want to learn the current fundamental concepts related to fetal health surveillance. It is designed for:

 Care providers with clinical experience as part of their regular review of fetal health surveillance knowledge, skills and clinical decision making.

 New obstetrical care providers as an adjunct to their facility orientation program.

The FHS Course consists of three components:

- ✓ Pre-workshop Study of the Fetal Health Surveillance On-line Learning Modules from the University of British Columbia Faculty of Medicine CPD.
- ✓ Completion of the On-line Exam upon completion of the Online Modules
- ✓ Face-to-Face Workshop with an emphasis on Case studies and interprofessional teamwork and communication.
