

Graduate **Reconciliation Award** Form

Value: \$18,000

Description: Funded by the Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR), Saskatchewan Health Research Foundation (SHRF) and Canadian Nurses Association (CNA), the University of Saskatchewan, Indigenous Research Chair in Nursing, will provide an annual award to graduates of a nursing program pursuing a master or doctoral degree. Applicants will focus their research in the area of Indigenous (First Nation, Métis, and Inuit) wellness. Preference will be given to applicants who are exploring mentorship and reconciliation in nursing practice, research, education and administration.

Eligibility: Applicants must have current licensure with the Saskatchewan Registered Nurses Association (SRNA) or with their provincial or territorial licensing body. Preference will be given to Saskatchewan applicants. The applicant must have at least one or more years of nursing experience following graduation. - 7. Transcripts or copy of academic record.
