Determining the Winning Team

- The use of debriefing allows for learning and knowledge development
- Simulation and debriefing are safe environments to discuss the simulation and events of the scenario
- Facilitators assist with reflection of the simulation and encourage critical thinking. The facilitators are co-learners in the simulation.

The SimWar is a friendly competition between three teams chosen by the event organizers, the team members will be involved in the Interprofessional Educational Experience. This pilot project was designed to allow for the opportunity to collaborate with other health professional students in clinically simulated scenarios.

The focus of the experience is to gain knowledge and competency related to leadership and teamwork. The scenarios developed will challenge your knowledge and critical examination of the entire situation.

The accumulation of points will be determined by the success of your team with a focus on interprofessional collaboration, communication and a coordinated effort participating in the scenarios and debriefing.

The end of the day will conclude with a ProAction Café which will assist with knowledge translation and discussion of the interprofessional competencies necessary for health care today.

The team that accumulates the most points will be announced during the Canadian Nursing Students' Association conference banquet
