



New!! College of Nursing - U of S Regina Campus Celebration Bursary

In celebration of the new University of Saskatchewan Regina Campus, the College of Nursing is offering a one-time \$2,000 bursary. This bursary is open to all students who apply to the U of S Bachelor of Science in Nursing Undergraduate program. One bursary of \$2,000 will be awarded to each student who chooses to take their nursing program in Regina, SK, and successfully registers (min. 6 credit units) at the new U of S Regina Campus in September 2013.

University of Saskatchewan Regina Campus Celebration Bursary FAQs

- 1. What is the amount of the bursary?
 - \$2,000 per student
- 2. Who is eligible for the bursary?
 - Any student who successfully registers for a minimum of 6 cu to begin classes in September 2013 in the U of S Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Undergraduate program at the new U of S Regina Campus.
- 3. How do students apply for the bursary?
 - There is no need to apply. Bursaries will automatically be applied to the accounts of those students who qualify (see #2).
- 4. Will this be an annual bursary?
 - No. This is a one-time offering.
- 5. Why is this bursary being offered?
 - This one-time bursary is being offered in celebration of the new U of S Regina Campus, home to the College of Nursing.
- 6. Are students from other U of S College of Nursing sites eligible for this bursary?
 - No. This bursary is being offered in celebration of the new U of S campus in Regina only.
- 7. Why didn't current Year 2 BSN students in Regina receive this bursary when they registered in September 2012?
 - This bursary was created after the official grand opening of the U of S Regina Campus in November 2012. As indicated above, these students will automatically receive this bursary when they successfully register for Year 3 of the BSN program at the new U of S Regina Campus.
- 8. Can a student still apply to the BSN program for September 2013 in Regina and receive this bursary?
 - Yes. The application deadline for the U of S Regina Campus is May 1, 2013.
