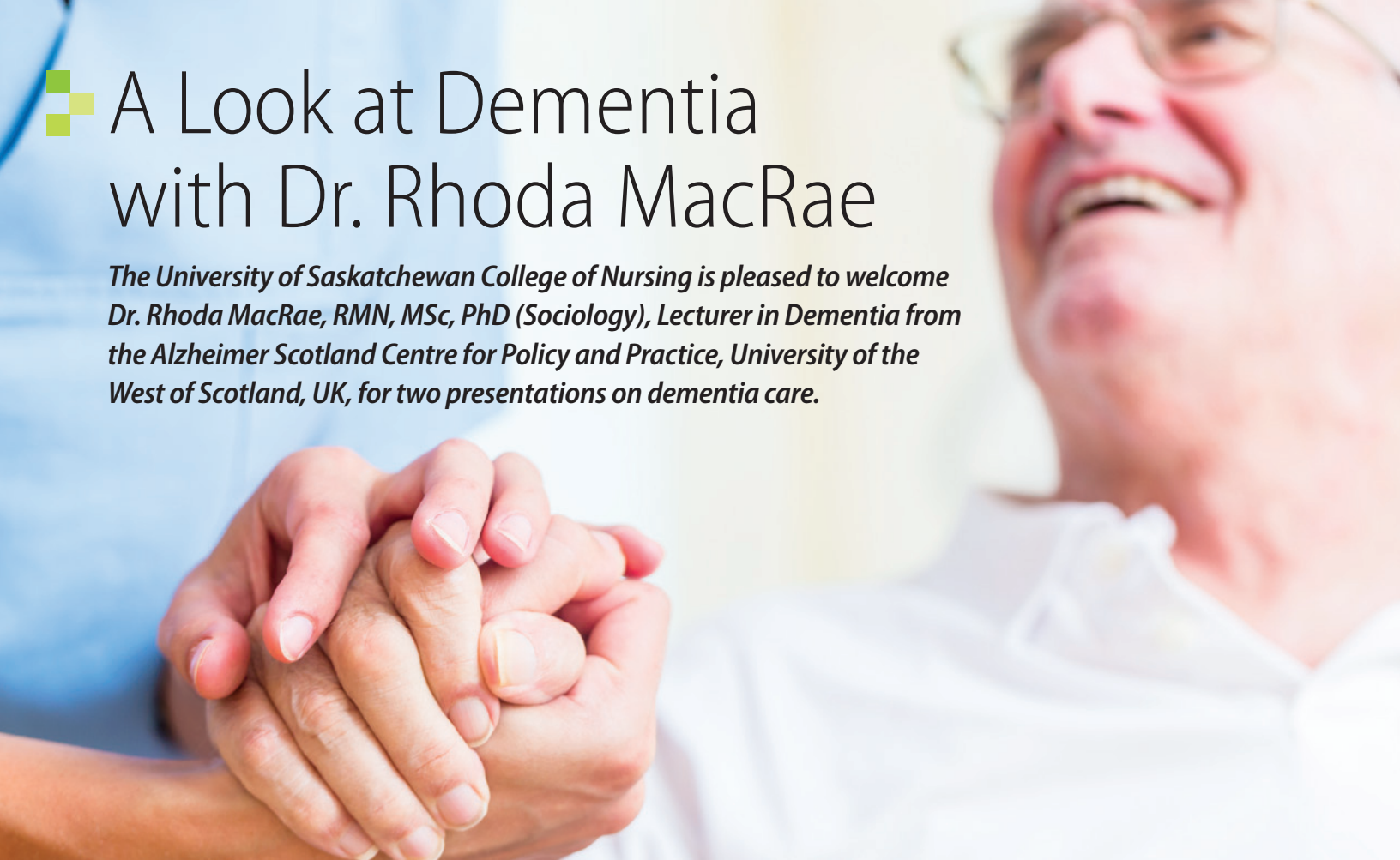


A Look at Dementia with Dr. Rhoda MacRae
